

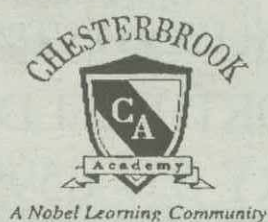

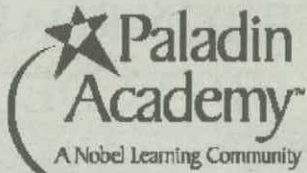

## You don't have to be a movie star to bathe in their tubs, but some are

NORTHFIELD — You might not have the need for a seven-foot by six-foot Jacuzzi tub with a 42-inch plasma television, underwater mood lighting and a floating remote but if you do, Artistic Hardware, a Northfield-based supplier and retailer of unique, upscale fixtures is a place to find one. It is also a place where filmmakers, with a need for that very special tub, can find it.

A few years ago, Artistic's owner, Pat McCarthy, was lucky enough to meet Chuck Potter, a set designer working on location in Atlantic City. Because of this chance meeting, McCarthy found a nice niche market supplying materials for television and movie sets.

Artistic has been supplying

HBO's "Sex in the City" with fixtures for the past three seasons. There you might see that Jacuzzi.

At present, Artistic supplies fixtures to roughly ten to twelve movies a year. Working with set designers often means scrambling to find the pieces they need and getting them on location overnight. McCarthy admits this can be "lots of fun but they always need everything tomorrow."

The movie companies purchase most pieces but some are borrowed which was the case with the glass sink used on the set of "Meet the Parents" with Robert DeNiro and Ben Stiller. Currently, Artistic's products are in "School of Rock" starring Jack Black. The upcoming release of "Cold Mountain" will also utilize hardware supplied by Artistic.

Of course, Artistic does more than just supply Hollywood. Artistic works with local builders, decorators and architects, all mostly involved in high-end new construction.

While Artistic does retail business, it is not your local home center. According to McCarthy, "we try to set ourselves apart from the home centers."

Artistic works mostly with referred customers, assisting their clients from the planning stages through the final construction phase. "Building a house can become overwhelming so we try to hold their (the clients) hand through it," said McCarthy.

Artistic Hardware is located at 201 Tilton Rd. Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Friday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The stage was simple and quiet as two old friends sat on a park bench like bookends. And so began a two-hour concert with Simon and Garfunkle at Boardwalk Hall on Friday, Nov. 28. They kicked off their "Old Friends" concert with the song of the same name. The duo had not performed in Atlantic City in nearly four decades. This time, the Everly Brothers warmed up the crowd.

The sold-out show did not disappoint the 13,800 who came to hear the songs that defined an era. The years have been kind to the voices of Paul Simon and Art Garfunkle. Garfunkle's range showed no signs of rust and maintains an almost choirboy ability to hit high notes. Both

men will turn 62 during the tour. Simon was a work horse on the guitar as well as singing.

"Hazy Shade of Winter" allowed the duo and their backup to get loose and jazzy but it was the ballads, like "An American Tune" that took listeners back to high school in just a few chords. "The Sounds of Silence" was like listening to a favorite album while getting ready to go out on a Friday night. Photos flashed across the screen like a montage of a generation ago. When scenes from "The Graduate" flashed the crowd knew "Mrs. Robinson" was not far behind.

The pair returned for two encores. With nearly everyone joining in at the end, it was plain that no one wanted these old friends to stop singing.
